Free Daylily Price and Reference Guide

Would you like to have access to a daylily Price and Reference Guide? There is now one available for free. There are already over 6,000 daylilies listed in the database. You can search daylily listings by cultivar name, hybridizer, seller, and country. You can also rate daylilies anonymously as to how they grow in your region. If you are looking for a hard to find daylily or just can't find it for sale, you can add it to a global wishlist. The wishlist lets sellers know that a particular daylily is wanted. You can add daylilies to your favorites list to help you keep track of your cultivars. When you find daylilies that you desire, you can add them to your inquiry list. When you are ready to contact the seller(s), you click preview from your inquiry list and it will automatically create an email to the seller (giving you a chance to edit before sending). Register for free at www.TheDaylilyAddict.com

If you are a seller, you can list your daylilies for free until June 2014. After that it will be \$100 for one year which includes a display advertisement. View the <u>How To Video on</u> Selling and start listing your daylilies for sale.

Future plans are to include an app for your smart phones so you can check prices when you are at a garden and add the cultivar to your favorites list.
